Join our team! As our Custodian, you will have responsibility for ensuring quality guest experience by performing a variety of custodial and housekeeping functions to maintain the cleanliness and care of the Museum. You will report to the Buildings and Grounds Manager and be a contributing member of the Museum Experiences and Environments team. This job is a non-exempt, part-time position. Estimated hours will be 6 hours/week, and are primarily anticipated during early mornings or evenings both weekdays and weekends. Actual hours will vary based on ongoing needs and Museum activities and will be determined in direct coordination with the Buildings and Grounds Manager. This position is not eligible for benefits or PTO. This position is eligible for overtime. Key attributes include dependability, self-motivation and flexibility, time management and the ability to maintain a positive attitude while dealing with the unexpected. Further, as the Museum is a growing, inclusive organization, any candidate should be open to performing a variety of tasks.

Primary Duties, but are not limited to:

- Cleans building floors by sweeping, mopping, scrubbing, or vacuuming.
- Clean and sanitize restrooms.
- Restock supplies in restrooms and dispensers in common areas.
- Cleans windows, glass partitions, plexi-glass and mirrors.
- Take out all trash and recycling.
- Cleans and dusts furniture, fixtures, railings, ledges, and other common areas.
- Completes exhibit cleaning as scheduled.
- Cleans offices, breakroom, conference rooms, community room as scheduled.
- Maintain janitorial supplies and equipment in clean, safe and operable condition.

- Other routine cleaning and maintenance duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Good communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to prioritize multiple tasks.
- Ability to work effectively with a team as needed.
- Ability to work independently as needed.
- Basic knowledge of cleaning products.

Work Conditions:

- Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 30 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 10 pounds of force constantly to lift, carry, push, and pull or otherwise move objects.
- Job requires ability to stand and walk for extended periods of time.
- Job requires stooping, kneeling, crouching and bending.
