

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

BABY PLAY:

Join us on the Infant and Toddler Play Porch! STEAM FRIDAYS:

Join us on Friday mornings for some outdoor STEAM in the Dotson Back 40! This come and go program will feature all your favorite ways to explore Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math.
