In preparation for your child's upcoming visit to the Children's Museum of Southern Minnesota with his or her class, program, camp, or group, here are a few things that you can do to help ensure a great visit to the Museum:

- Read the Museum's Social Story together (accessible online at: [www.cmsouthernmn.org/wp-content/uploads/2015/04/School-Group-Social-Story-2018.pdf](http://www.cmsouthernmn.org/wp-content/uploads/2015/04/School-Group-Social-Story-2018.pdf)) to learn about the Museum's exhibits and activities.
- Have your child eat a healthy breakfast the day of the visit, to have fuel for fun adventures in the Museum!
- Plan for your child to wear comfortable clothing and closed-toe shoes that will protect his/her feet while exploring the Museum's exhibits.
- Practice using walking feet and inside voices together before the day of the visit.
